

What We Learned In This Lesson

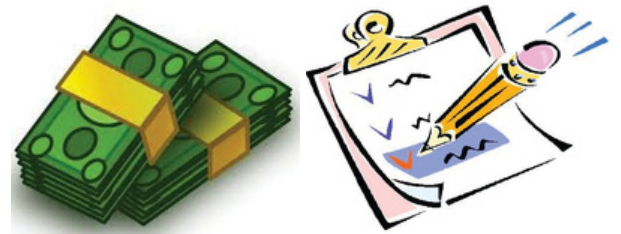
Before there was money, people used to exchange things with one another. This is called **BARTER TRADE**.



BARTER TRADE = Two people exchanging goods **WITHOUT** the use of money.

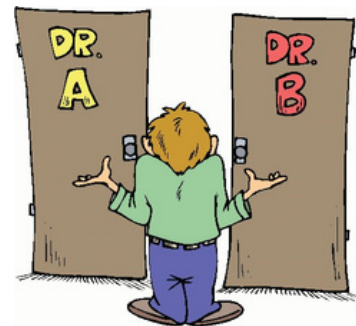
What Can Money Do?

MONEY = CHOICE

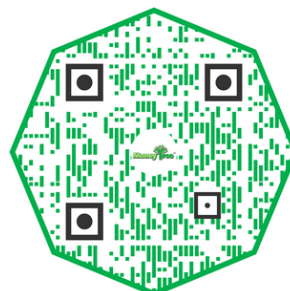
The More Money You Have,

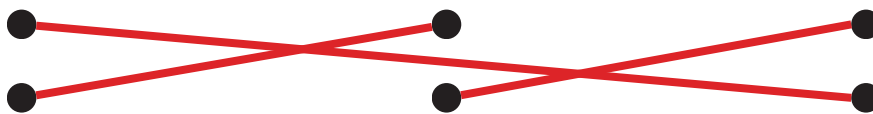
